

SHARON LINDAN MAYL currently serves as the Senior Advisor for Policy to the Deputy Commissioner for Foods and Veterinary Medicine. In this position, she oversees and manages significant policy initiatives for the Office of Foods and Veterinary Medicine. She currently focuses on implementation of the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA). Ms. Mayl is also the co-lead for the FSMA import operational team that will prepare the Agency for its transition from policy setting to compliance in the next phase of FSMA implementation.
